COMMUNITY CHEST HEARTSTRINGS WALK 2022 FAQs

(A) ABOUT THE EVENT

1. What are the different segments of Community Chest Heartstrings Walk 2022?

The **Community Chest Heartstrings Walk 2022** comprises of the "Charity Fun Walk" and the "Virtual Walk".

The Charity Fun Walk is a physical, 4km non-competitive walk that will take place on 10 September 2022 at the Marina Bay Waterfront Promenade.

• Date: 10 September 2022, Saturday

• Flag-off time: 7.15pm

• Venue: Event Plaza, Marina Bay Sands, 10 Bayfront Avenue, Singapore 018956

Distance: 4km

• Registration fee: \$25 per pax | \$80 per group of 4 pax

*The route is friendly for those with mobility issues (e.g., using wheelchair or kaye walker).



The Virtual Walk allows the community to participate at their own comfort and pace. The Virtual Walk will start with a milestone of 3km and participants are encouraged to clock 39km, in celebration of Community Chest's 39th anniversary.

Registration fee: \$15 per individual

• Registration period: 1st August – 18th September 2022

• Participation period: 1st August - 2nd October 2022

2. What are the causes that Community Chest supports?

Community Chest's supported causes are:

- 1. Adults with disabilities
- 2. Children with special needs and youth-at-risk
- 3. Families in need of assistance
- 4. Persons with mental health conditions
- 5. Seniors in need of support

3. Where will the registration fees from Charity Fun Walk and Virtual Walk go to? As Community Chest's fundraising and operating costs are covered mainly by Tote Board, 100% of the funds raised through Community Chest Heartstrings Walk 2022 will go to Community Chest to support over 100 social service agencies and 200 critical programmes supported by Community Chest, to empower the lives of children with special needs and youth-at-risk, adults with disabilities, persons with mental health conditions, and seniors and families in need of assistance. 4. Why am I charged a small fee during checkout? 100% of the registration fees will be channelled to over 100 social service agencies and 200 critical programmes supported by Community Chest. Apart from the registration fee, there is a payment processing fee of 3.4% per transaction charged solely by the payment platform provider Stripe, during checkout,. For instance, the total fees charged for the Charity Fun Walk is \$25.85. This includes the \$25 registration fee channelled to Community Chest, and a \$0.85 payment processing fee charged by Stripe. 5. Will the registration fee be tax deductible? Registration fees for the Charity Fun Walk and Virtual Walk are not tax deductible.

3.	How do I sign up as a group?			
	You can rally family and friends to form a team of 4 people to enjoy group registration rate.			
	To register as a team, please select the "Charity Fun Walk (Group of 4)" option and fill in the names of your team members on the registration form. As a team representative, you will be nominated as team leader by default.			

4. Can I change my team members after I have registered? Please email to enquiry@HSW2022.com to submit this request. 5. Can children join the event? Participants of all ages are welcome. Children below 12 years old and accompanied by an adult registrant can join in the Charity Fun Walk for free. Are we allowed to bring pets to the Charity Fun Walk? 6. Participants may bring their pets along to the Charity Fun Walk. However please note that the large crowd may cause stress for some pets. 7. What is the e-bib for? 9.	Where do I register and collect the lantern on the event day?				
	You may register and collect your lantern at the registration booths located at the Mari Bay Sands' Event Plaza. In commemoration of Community Chest's 39 th Anniversary, we we be giving out goodie bags and lanterns to the first 3,900 online registrants.				
	Please remember to bring your confirmation email with QR code (digital or printed copy) for registration. If you have signed up as a team, kindly note that only the names of the team leader and members submitted during online registration will be accepted.				
10.	Can I bring my own lantern to the walk?				
	Yes, you are welcome to bring your own lantern.				
11.	Is there a bag deposit?				
	There will not be any bag deposit areas at the Charity Fun Walk. Participants are encouraged to bring only necessary items.				
12.	Do I need to be fully vaccinated to participate in the Charity Fun Walk?				
	Yes, only fully vaccinated participants are allowed to join large scale events according to the current Safe Management Measures (SMM) guidelines. Prevailing SMM guidelines will apply and SMM will be undertaken at the event.				
	Mask-wearing is optional but encouraged for outdoor settings, especially in crowded areas during the event.

1.	What is the registration period?			
	Registration for the Virtual Walk starts on 1 st August 2022, 0900 hrs and ends on 18 th September 2022, 2359hrs.			
2.	Do I have to download the 42Race app to take part in the virtual walk?			
	It is not compulsory for Virtual Walk participants to download the 42Race app. If you wish to submit your clocked distance, you may do so at this <u>link</u> .			
3.	Can I form a team at the Virtual Walk?			
	You may form a team with your family and friends after they have registered online individually. The steps to form a team are: • Step 1: Log in to your account • Step 2: Go to profile and scroll down to "Community Chest Heartstrings Walk			
	 2022 – Virtual Walk" Step 3: Click "Team" Step 4: Click on "Create a Team". Type in your team's name and click "Create". For more information on how to create a team, please visit this guide by 42Race.

	While participants are encouraged to clock more walking distance, completing the virtual challenge of 39km is not mandatory for the Virtual Walk.					
8.	How do I track my walking distance?					
	You may use any GPS-enabled apps and devices to track your walking distance. Please refer to this <u>link</u> for the list of recommended apps and devices that you can use.					
9.	How do I submit the distance clocked from my GPS-enabled app/device through the 42Race website/app?					
	Please refer to the <u>user guide</u> on how to submit your walking distance.					
10.	I have completed the virtual challenge of clocking 39km. When and where can I download my finisher e-certificate?					
	Upon completion, please click the "Cert" icon located on the event card in your profile to download your finisher e-certificate.
