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Innovative Digital Fundraising Initiatives Mark 37 Years of Empowering Lives through Christmas On *A Great Street* Light-Up Ceremony

SINGAPORE, **13 NOVEMBER 2020** –The community has more ways to be part of the year-end festivities and do good at the same time, as this year's Christmas On *A Great Street* Light-Up Ceremony extends its reach island-wide to light up 13 CapitaLand malls across Singapore and introduces a slew of innovative digital fundraising initiatives. These were created in partnership with CapitaLand malls including ION Orchard, as well as Takashimaya Shopping Centre and DBS Bank, which have come onboard in a strong show of support for the vulnerable.

The annual **Christmas On** *A Great Street* **Light-Up Ceremony**, held in support of Community Chest and part of the SG Cares Giving Week, was launched officially by Guest-of-Honour President Halimah Yacob, at ION Orchard. Minister for Social and Family Development Masagos Zulkifli was present for the launch too. The event was marked by the customary light-up of Orchard Road, with ION Orchard and, for the first time, 13 CapitaLand Malls across Singapore, as a way to bring festive cheer to the heartlands and closer to people's homes. More than \$1.6 million has been raised through the event, benefitting over 80 social service agencies and 200 critical social service programmes supported by Community Chest.

To further leverage the festive shopping season and the spirit of giving, three digital fundraising initiatives were launched in conjunction with the Christmas On *A Great Street* Light-Up Ceremony. Through the **Brighten With Love** initiative, shoppers at CapitaLand malls including ION Orchard, as well as Takashimaya Shopping Centre, can donate a minimum of \$10 to Community Chest by scanning a PayNow QR code and receive a \$5 eCapitaMall promo code or voucher (for Takashimaya shoppers). Shoppers at CapitaLand malls can also support the **Celebrate With Love** initiative by donating their STAR\$[®] ¹ on the CapitaStar app or their ION⁺

Points to support social service agencies under the care of Community Chest. CapitaLand's philanthropic arm, CapitaLand Hope Foundation will match contributions made on the CapitaStar app to support disadvantaged children and vulnerable seniors under Community Chest, up to \$25,000.

- 4. Donors can also donate directly to Community Chest's **Win With Love** initiative via a PayNow QR code and stand a chance to win lucky draw prizes. All donations made via the PayNow or DBS PayLah! QR code will be matched by DBS Bank, which has committed to matching up to \$100,000 for donations. Said Mr Phillip Tan, Chairman of Community Chest, "We may be physically apart this year for the Christmas light-up, but the community feels closer than ever, thanks to the rallying effort of our partners who have pledged their resources to help fundraise for our social service agencies. Lighting up CapitaLand malls across Singapore is our way of thanking the community for their support this year despite the challenges, and also represents our hopes for a brighter and stronger Singapore in the new year. The pandemic will not diminish our spirit of solidarity."

Said Mr Tan Seng Chai, Chief Corporate & People Officer for CapitaLand Group and Executive Director of CapitaLand Hope Foundation, "Through our philanthropic arm CapitaLand Hope Foundation (CHF), we have been working with Community Chest for 12 years to help the disadvantaged, and we aim to further amplify our support by leveraging our digital platforms. CapitaLand has been accelerating our digitalisation efforts to position us for the new normal and we are extending this to our philanthropic support. This year, we are encouraging our shoppers at our participating malls including CapitaLand's curated digital mall, eCapitaMall, as well as the 1.1 million CapitaStar members to give back via the CapitaStar app to the vulnerable communities. Community Chest, as a fundraising arm of the National Council of Social Service, supporting about 80 social service agencies, will not be subject to the \$400,000 per IPC cap. Instead, 20% of the total donation (net of the donation that is already matched by existing grants) received by Community Chest in the qualifying period will be matched by the Bicentennial Community Fund.
