Over 650 volunteers to prepare 5,000 Ramadan festive packs for families in need from 19 constituencies across Singapore for first Community Chest Habuan Harapan 2024

Deputy Prime Minister Lawrence Wong, Minister for Social and Family Development Masagos Zulkifli and community partners join the Muslim community in breaking of fast

SINGAPORE, 13 MARCH 2024 – For the first time, Community Chest and volunteer group Heartwarmers are partnering with MUIS and Wisma Geylang Serai for the Community Chest Habuan Harapan event to welcome the fasting month of Ramadan with Malay Muslim families in need. The event brings together 13 corporate donors as well as 650 volunteers to pack and distribute the festive packages, which will be distributed to 5,000 families during the period of Ramadan.

2 Habuan Harapan, which translates as "the gift of hope", will have the festive packages distributed to Muslim recipients across 19 constituencies across Singapore such as Tampines East, Queenstown Leng Kee and Jurong Central.

3 Some 1,000 bags were assembled on the ceremony day, comprising 'green packets' (sampul duit raya) and festive goodies such as kueh kapet, ginger tea and keropok to supplement their preparation for Hari Raya celebrations. A further 4,000 bags will be packed for families in need, to be distributed at the end of March. The ceremony was attended by Guest-of-Honour Mr Lawrence Wong, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance and hosted by Mr Masagos Zulkifli, Minister for Social and Family Development and Second Minister for Health.

4 "Community Chest Habuan Harapan is our first collaboration that brings together corporate volunteers, donors and the Muslim community. It is heartening when we are able to connect with different communities to support and strengthen more families in Singapore together," said Mr Chew Sutat, Chairman of Community Chest.
